## *Canton Community Garden Rules*

The application and fee must be received by the City by Wednesday May 1st. The season fee for all garden sites shall be \$20.

Please turn the application and fee to City Hall. Garden placement is on a first-come, first-served basis.

The garden season fee pays for water, tilling expenses, and future garden investments.

Each plot will be 10 ft x 10 ft.

Plots will be tilled, staked, and ready to plant as soon as possible when spring weather permits. If you can volunteer to help set up the plots, it would be greatly appreciated. An email will be sent out with dates and times for this. The Community Garden Coordinator will also be contacting you via email when the garden is available. It will hopefully be ready early to mid-May.

As a community gardener, you are committing to maintain your plot for the entire growing season. You must clean out your plot by Saturday, October 16. Everything must be removed by this date, including plants, fencing, supports, landscape fabric, etc.

Anything you bring into the garden, you are expected to carry out; the gardens will have a garbage can available if you are unable to carry out rubbish. If you weed, please bring the weeds home to your trash can.

You are encouraged to make soil improvements in your plot using organic materials such as untreated lawn clippings, compost, or other fertilizers.

Water conservation is required.

You are responsible for grass and weed control in your plot and the pathways around your plot.

Commercial herbicides and pesticides are not allowed.

Be considerate. If you can help your neighbor, please do so.
